

# ***Gullah Heritage Tour***



Explore the roots of the rich Gullah culture in South Carolina's Treasured Coast, where great numbers of Africans were brought from the holds of ships. Here, in this strange and different world, they created a rich, vibrant Gullah culture and heritage still alive in the Lowcountry today.

- World-famous Lowcountry cuisine, including Daufuskie Deviled Crabs and Frogmore Stew at restaurants owned by local native islanders
- Gullah arts and crafts shopping at local art shops
- Inspiring local gospel choir music and jazz
